The organization is always looking for ways to promote the concept of adopting pets in need first, before going to a breeder. This year they have decided to have a Valentine's Day themed adoption event, on Feb. 14, 2022, at Piedmont Park in Atlanta.

Since the event takes place in a park, the majority of the pets up for adoption are dogs but a few of the more out-going cats are expected to be there, also.
